Learning basic code regulations to keep **Your Home** clean and safe

•Fire Prevention/Protection

Outside Burning (See Garbage & Waste)

It shall be unlawful for any person to burn any combustible material upon any street in the city. Sec 10-2

Evacuation of Buildings

All residents or occupants shall immediately evacuate any building in which a fire alarm has been sounded, or when directed to do so by an appropriate official agent of the State, City, County or University. Sec. 10-6.

•Animals/ Pets

Noisy Animals

Noisy animals and barking dogs are prohibited (Sec. 6-6.

Dogs Running at Large

Dogs running at large are prohibited. Dogs outside must be leashed, restricted from leaving the owner's property, or in control of the owner while indoors. Dogs observed running loose may be picked up and taken to the McDonough County Animal Shelter. Sec 6-32.

Tags

Every dog owner shall keep a collar around the neck of the dog with the license tag securely attached thereto. Sec. 6-51.

(Fine = the cost incurred by Animal Shelter).

Rabies Shots

Cat and Dog owners must keep their pets inoculated against rabies by a licensed vet.

Sec. 6-72.

(Fine = the cost incurred by Animal Shelter).

•Home Modifications

Don't make any structural modifications to your home without contacting the Community Development Office first. Many code regulations apply to the specifications of what can and can't be done to your home.

•Miscellaneous

Indoor Furniture Outdoors

Indoor furniture is prohibited outdoors or on outdoor porches. Sec 302-10.

Nuisance parties

No person who is an owner, occupant, tenant, or who otherwise has rightful possession or possessory control, individually or jointly with others, of any premises shall knowingly, negligently, or recklessly allow a social gathering or party on said premises to become a nuisance party. Sec. 16-16.1

Games & Other Activities on Streets, Sidewalks

It is unlawful to play games or other activities on public streets and sidewalks where such activities interfere with pedestrians or traffic. Sec. 20-11.
