DOWNTOWN REVITALIZATION PROJECT WEEKLY UPDATE

MACOMB, IL- McCarthy Improvement (MCI) will continue to pour sidewalks on W. Jackson Street, weather permitting, and asphalt work will be performed the week of August 23, 2021. When asphalt work is being done on West Jackson, parking will be prohibited on the west side of North and South Lafayette St. After the asphalt work temporary pavement markings will be placed. Once W. Jackson St. is complete, they will begin to transition to the east side of the Square. They plan to start at the northeast corner of Randolph St. and Carroll St. on August 23, 2021.

In order to minimize business interruptions, MCI will be working in smaller sections, approximately 1 block, during the remaining stages.

Please remember, during this process, please be cautious while driving or walking near the work zone and proceed carefully as the concrete will be wet.

Entrances to the businesses will be accessible through the construction process. As the contractor is pouring sidewalks in front of businesses, pedestrian walkways will continue to shift through this process. Pedestrians are encouraged to pay attention to the changing walk patterns.
