DOWNTOWN REVITALIZATION PROJECT WEEKLY UPDATE

MACOMB, IL- McCarthy Improvement has completed East Jackson Street and the street will be back open to traffic tomorrow, Thursday, May 5, 2022. MCI will continue to work on South Lafayette Street. During this construction traffic North bound coming onto the square on South Lafayette will remain closed. All traffic going south bound exiting the square on South Lafayette will remain open.

Contractors will continue to work on curb & gutter and pouring sidewalks on the west side of North Randolph Street. South bound traffic coming onto the square on North Randolph will remain closed for the rest of this phase. All Traffic going north bound exiting the square on North Randolph will remain open.

McCarthy Improvement will begin breaking concrete on the east side of North Lafayette for the remainder of the week and traffic will remain open. Starting Monday, May 9, 2022 contractors will begin removing concrete on the east side of N. Lafayette Street. During this construction traffic South Bound will remain open. All traffic exiting on North Randolph will be closed.

McCarthy Improvement plans to complete the project has been updated as follows:

- East Jackson St.
- South Lafayette Street (East Side) and North Randolph Street (West Side)
- North Lafayette Street (East Side)
- North Side Square
- South Side Square
- South Randolph Street (West Side)

Entrances to the businesses will be accessible through the construction process. As the contractor is pouring sidewalks in front of businesses, pedestrian walkways will continue to shift through this process. Pedestrians are encouraged to pay attention to the changing walk patterns.

The estimated date of completion for the entire Downtown Revitalization Project is September 2022. More information can be found on the City Macomb Website, Downtown
