Preventive care benefits for adults

All Marketplace health plans and many other plans must cover the following list of preventive services without charging you a copayment or coinsurance. This is true even if you haven't met your yearly deductible.

IMPORTANT

These services are free only when delivered by a doctor or other provider in your plan's network.

- 1. <u>Abdominal aortic aneurysm one-time screening (http://healthfinder.gov/HealthTopics/Category/doctor-visits/screening-tests/talk-to-your-doctor-about-abdominal-aortic-aneurysm)</u> for men of specified ages who have ever smoked
- 2. <u>Alcohol misuse screening and counseling (http://healthfinder.gov/HealthTopics/Category/healthconditions-and-diseases/heart-health/drink-alcohol-only-in-moderation)</u>
- 3. <u>Aspirin use (http://healthfinder.gov/HealthTopics/Category/health-conditions-and-diseases/heart-health/talk-with-your-doctor-about-taking-aspirin-every-day)</u> to prevent cardiovascular disease and colorectal cancer for adults 50 to 59 years with a high cardiovascular risk
- 4. <u>Blood pressure screening (http://healthfinder.gov/HealthTopics/Category/doctor-visits/screening-tests/get-your-blood-pressure-checked)</u>
- 5. <u>Cholesterol screening (http://healthfinder.gov/HealthTopics/Category/doctor-visits/screening-tests/get-your-cholesterol-checked)</u> for adults of certain ages or at higher risk
- 6. <u>Colorectal cancer screening (http://healthfinder.gov/HealthTopics/Category/doctor-visits/screening-tests/gettested-for-colorectal-cancer)</u> for adults 45 to 75

- 8. <u>Diabetes (Type 2) screening (http://healthfinder.gov/HealthTopics/Category/health-conditions-and-diseases/diabetes/take-steps-to-prevent-type-2-diabetes)</u> for adults 40 to 70 years who are overweight or obese
- 9. <u>Diet counseling (http://healthfinder.gov/HealthTopics/Category/health-conditions-and-diseases/diabetes/eat-healthy)</u> for adults at higher risk for chronic disease

- 10. <u>Falls prevention</u> (with exercise or physical therapy and vitamin D use) for adults 65 years and over, living in a community setting
- 11. <u>Hepatitis B screening</u> for people at high risk, including people from countries with 2% or more Hepatitis B prevalence, and U.S.-born people not vaccinated as infants and with at least one parent born in a region with 8% or more Hepatitis B prevalence.
- 12. <u>Hepatitis C screening (http://healthfinder.gov/HealthTopics/Category/doctor-visits/talking-with-the-doctor/hepatitis-c-screening)</u> for adults age 18 to 79 years
- 13. <u>HIV screening (http://healthfinder.gov/HealthTopics/Category/health-conditions-and-diseases/hiv-and-other-stds/get-tested-for-hiv)</u> for everyone age 15 to 65, and other ages at increased risk
- 14. <u>PrEP (pre-exposure prophylaxis) HIV prevention medication</u> for HIV-negative adults at high risk for getting HIV through sex or injection drug use
- 15. <u>Immunizations (http://healthfinder.gov/HealthTopics/Category/doctor-visits/shotsvaccines/get-important-shots)</u> for adults doses, recommended ages, and recommended populations vary:
 - o <u>Chickenpox (Varicella) (http://www.vaccines.gov/diseases/chickenpox/index.html)</u>
 - o <u>Diphtheria</u>
 - Flu (influenza)
 - Hepatitis A
 - Hepatitis B
 - o Human Papillomavirus (HPV)
 - o <u>Measles</u>
 - Meningococcal
 - o <u>Mumps</u>
 - Whooping Cough (Pertussis)
 - Pneumococcal
 - Rubella
 - Shingles
 - <u>Tetanus</u>
- 16. <u>Lung cancer screening</u> for adults 50 to 80 at high risk for lung cancer because they're heavy smokers or have quit in the past 15 years
- 17. <u>Obesity screening and counseling (http://healthfinder.gov/HealthTopics/Category/health-conditions-and-diseases/diabetes/watch-your-weight)</u>

- 18. <u>Sexually transmitted infection (STI) prevention counseling</u>
