ITEMS **NOT** INCLUDED IN THE CLEAN UP:

YARD WASTE

PREPARATION:

Items should be placed at the curb for collection the night before your regular service day. Clean Up collection begins at 6:00 AM. Whenever possible, materials should be placed in cans, bags or bundles weighing less than 50#. Large items (furniture, etc.) should be placed as near to the curb as possible. Waste Management also reserves the right to not accept any item that may pose a safety/health hazard to our employees.

Effective January 1, 2012 all of the *covered electronic devices* listed below are banned from landfills.
