Refuse, Recycling and Yard Waste Program

Trash Service: There is a 96 gallon wheeled collection cart for regular trash, a 96 gallon wheeled collection cart for recycles material. The Yellow lid cart is to be used for recycle only. Any trash that is not valid recycle placed in this cart will not be picked up by Waste Management.

An additional cart is available for a monthly rental and may be ordered through Waste Management at 1-800-796-9696.

Extra bags may be placed next to the cart but they will be required to have a white tag (\$1.50) attached for pick up. These tags may be purchased at local grocery, and hardware stores as well as the Macomb City Hall Business Office.

Holiday Schedule: Waste Management observes the following holidays. When your scheduled service day falls on or after a holiday, your collection will be postponed by one day.

Refuse Collection: This collection is performed every week. Please place the cart at the curb the evening before your pick up day with at least 3 foot separation between carts and obstructions for the automatic side-load truck. Waste collection begins at 6:00 a.m. Summer hours may vary.

Recycling Collection: The recycle container collection occurs every other week. A schedule may be obtained by contacting the City of Macomb Public Works Department at 833-2821.

Metal or Cans – recycle any aluminum, tin, or bi-metal cans that contained food or beverages. Labels do not need to be removed.

Cardboard – Only corrugated and chipboard are accepted for recycling. Flatten and bundle boxes and place them in the cart. No wax coated milk or juice cartons are accepted.

Glass – Recycle clear, green or brown unbroken glass jars, and bottles and jugs that contained food or beverages. NO windows, auto glass, or dishes. Labels do not have to be removed.

Paper – Newspaper, envelopes, copy paper, magazines, junk mail, and manila folders are acceptable. NO construction or neon colored paper will be acceptable.

Plastics – Remove all caps from containers. NO styrofoam, plastic salad/fruit containers, plastic plates or black microwave trays.

Bulk Collection: Bulk items such as furniture and large appliances require a “Bulk” sticker and may be purchased at the Macomb City Hall Business office and various retail stores. The cost is \$20.00 per item.

Yard Waste Collection:

- Generally the yard waste collection begins the 2nd Monday in March to the 2nd Thursday in December. Any changes to this scheduled will be announced through the media and placed on the City of Macomb Web Page.
- Yard waste must be placed in kraft-type paper bags, trash cans or bundles. Bags, bundles or cans may not exceed 50#. Each bag, can or bundle must have a yard waste sticker attached for collection. Stickers are available at various retail outlets and the City of Macomb Business Office at a cost of \$1.50 per container.
- Brush and branches must be cut to 4-foot lengths and tied with twine only into bundles less than 2 feet in diameter. Bundles may not exceed 50#. Bundles tied with wire will not be collected.
- The City of Macomb offers “No Sticker” yard waste bag service in the Spring and Fall of the year. During that period all yard waste placed at the curb will be collected without stickers. All guidelines for size and weight of materials remain the same.
- The “**No Sticker**” Yard Waste Pick up with the effective dates will be announced through the media and placed on the City of Macomb Web Page.
