As a condition of the issuance of this Conditional Use Permit/Certificate of Occupancy for the above stated temporary use, the applicant agrees to the following conditions as per Article 7, Chapter 4, Section 2 of the Macomb Unified Development Code (Ordinance 2750).

1. All temporary uses shall be conducted behind the building setback line except as otherwise permitted by the City Council.
2. Construction trailers, equipment storage sheds and portable lavatories shall meet the following conditions:
  - a. The trailer, shed or portable lavatory shall be incidental to construction;
  - b. The trailer, shed or portable lavatory shall be located on the same lot as the construction or on an abutting lot;
  - c. The trailer, shed or portable lavatory shall remain on the property no longer than the time of construction;
  - d. The trailer, shed or portable lavatory shall be located no closer than twenty (20) feet from any public street or any other property located in a residential district.
  - e. Any sign located on the trailer shall be considered the construction sign permitted pursuant to Article 7, Chapter 3 of the Macomb Unified Development Code.
3. Tents shall meet the following conditions:
  - a. All tents shall be constructed of flame retardant material and erected securely. Guy wires, stakes or other supports shall be clearly marked and secured.
  - b. Tents shall require a setback of at least five (5) feet from side and rear property lines.
  - c. Lighting or other electrical equipment shall be installed in accordance with the city's electrical code.
  - d. Tents shall be erected for no longer than seven (7) days in residential districts and 30 days in commercial and industrial districts, except as otherwise provided by the Community Development Coordinator.
4. Art, Craft and Book, and Sidewalk Sales and similar uses as determined by the Community Development Coordinator shall meet the following conditions:
  - a. No more than three (3) may be held in a twelve (12) month period and each may not be longer than two (2) days in length.
